DESCRIPTION

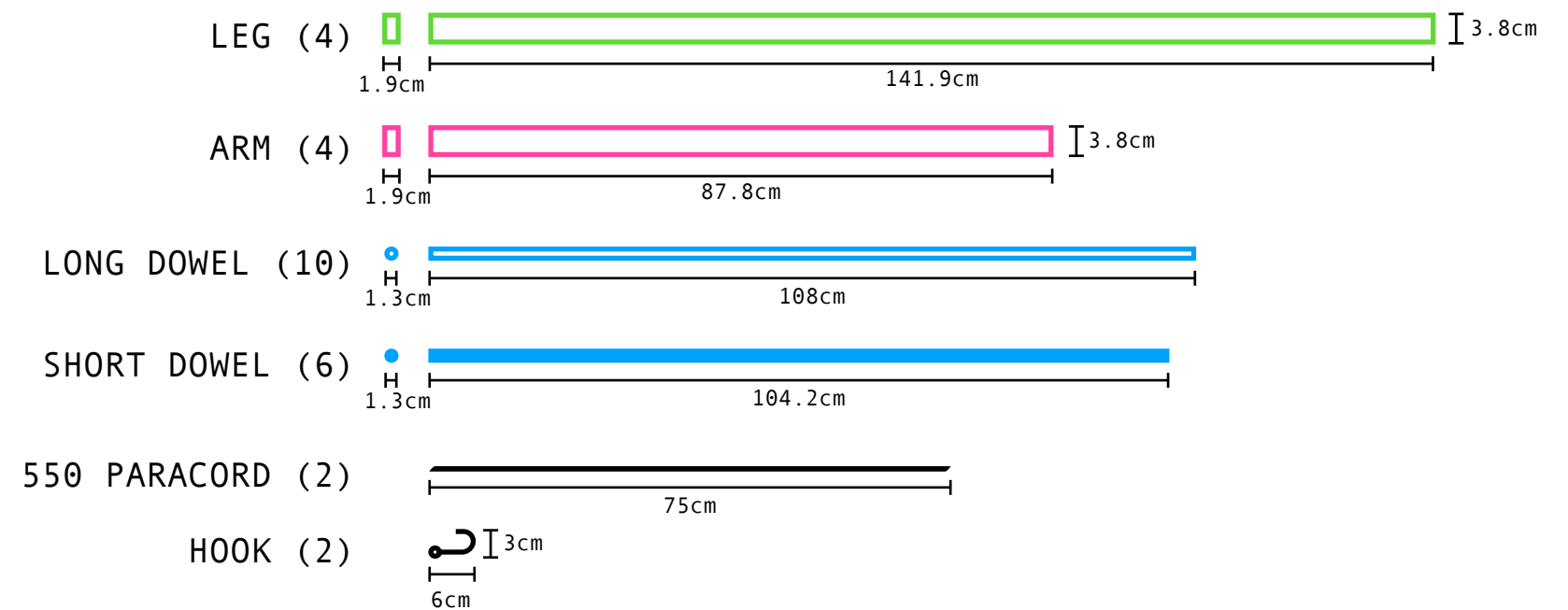
This clothes drying rack stands approximately 121cm tall, and spans approximately 1m by 1.7m. When not in use, it folds near flat, to approximately 25cm at its widest point, for easy storage.

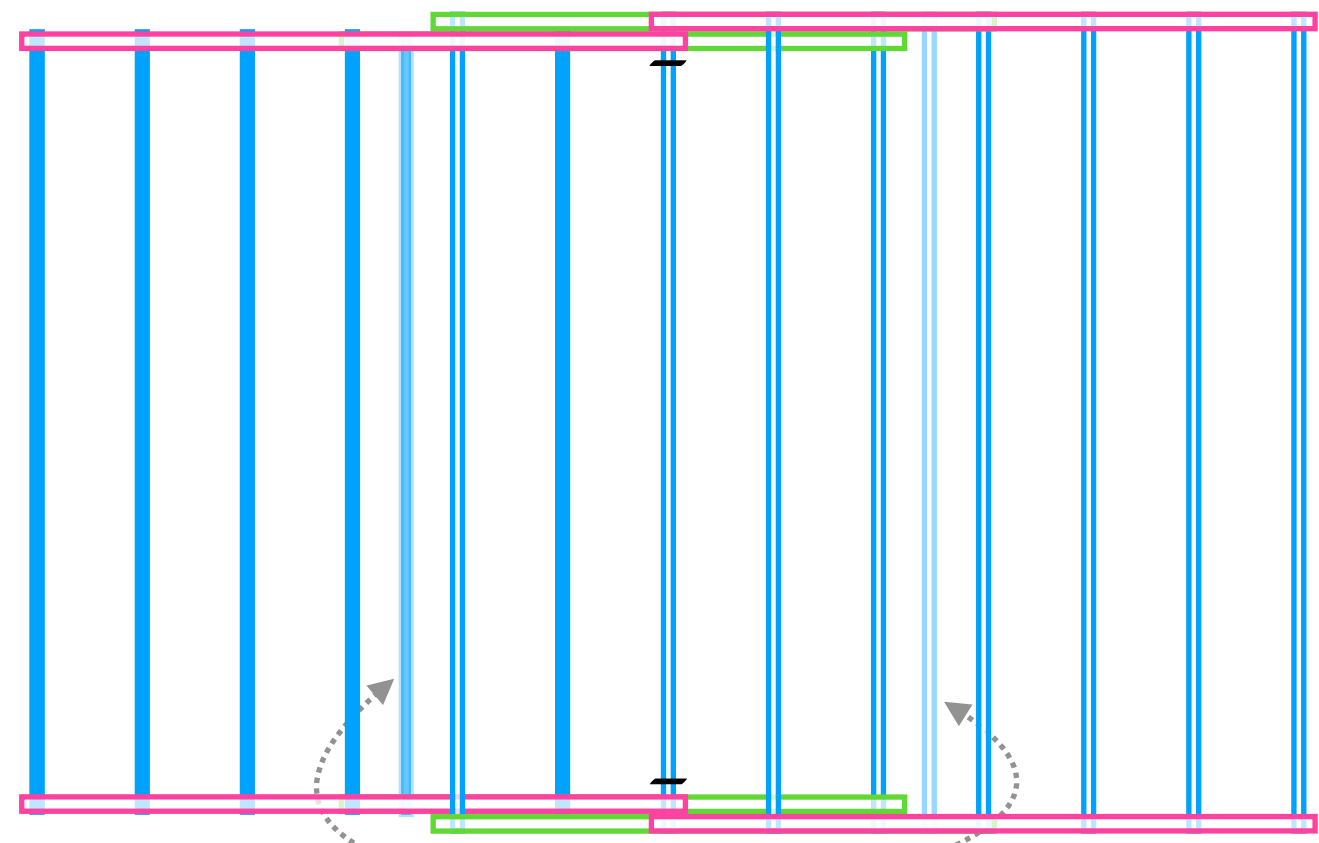


ASSEMBLY NOTES

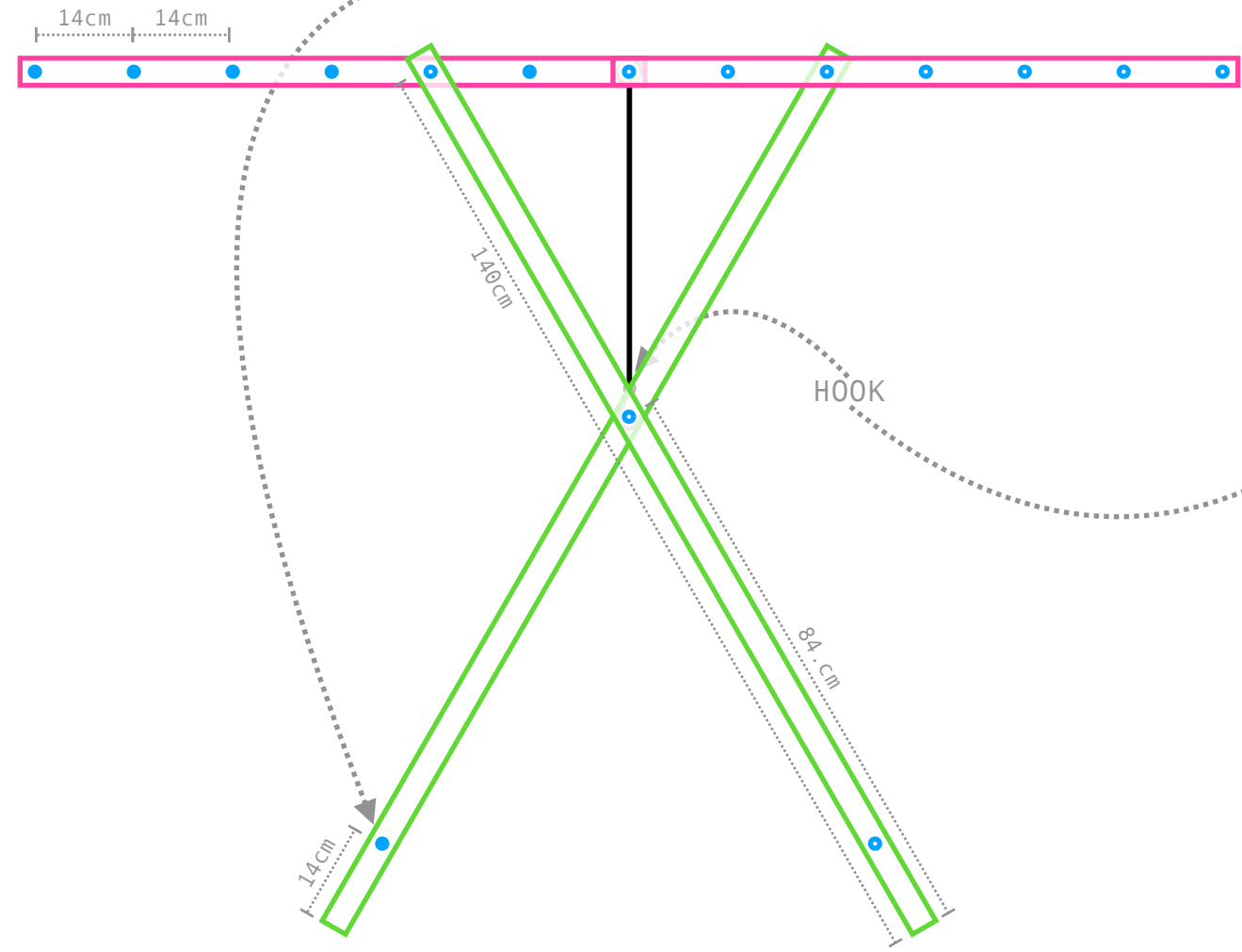
1. Any dowel that passes through two arms, two legs, or one of each, should be affixed (glued, pinned, wedged, etc.) to only one of them. Fixing to the outermost component will likely be the most structurally stable. Fixing to the innermost component may allow disassembly.
2. Paint or other finish will be most easily applied before assemble. Take care not to apply finish to the ends of the dowels, or to the inside of the holes. The dowels may not fit, or glue may not stick otherwise.
3. Suggested knots for the paracord are a [snell knot](#) to attach the hook, and a [buntline hitch](#) to attach to the upper dowel.
4. Builders in the U.S.A. will find that a surfaced 1x2, and a 1/2" dowel will each have dimensions approximately matching those given above.

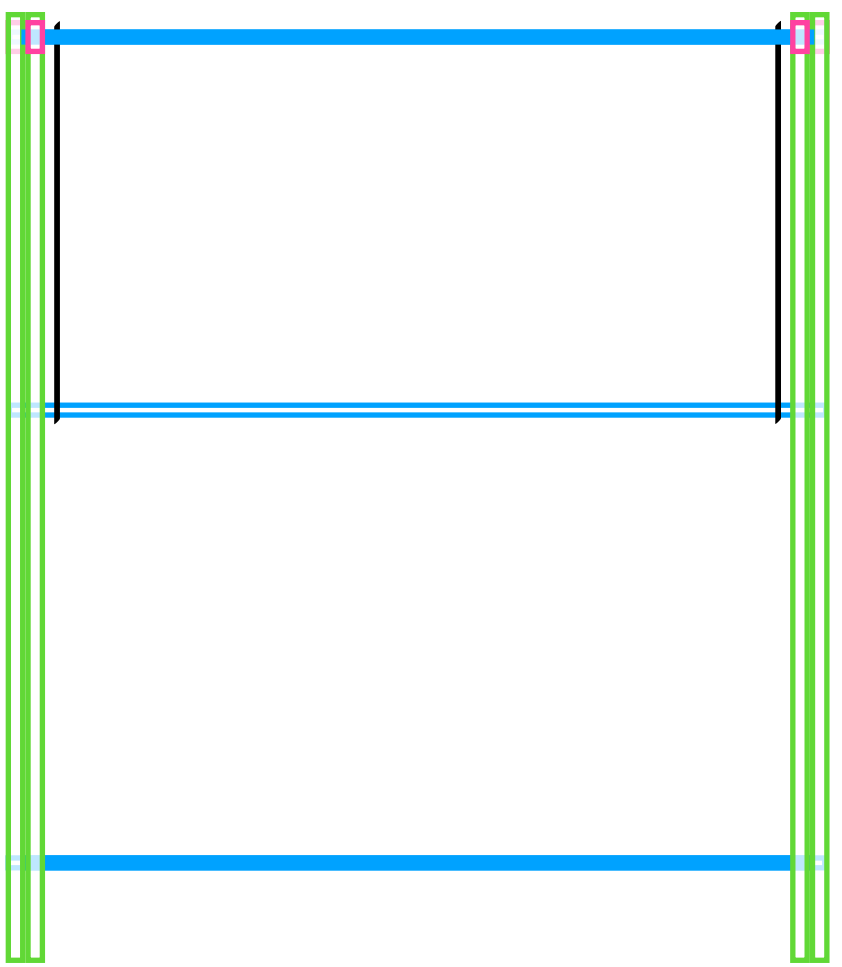


LOWER LEG DOWELS

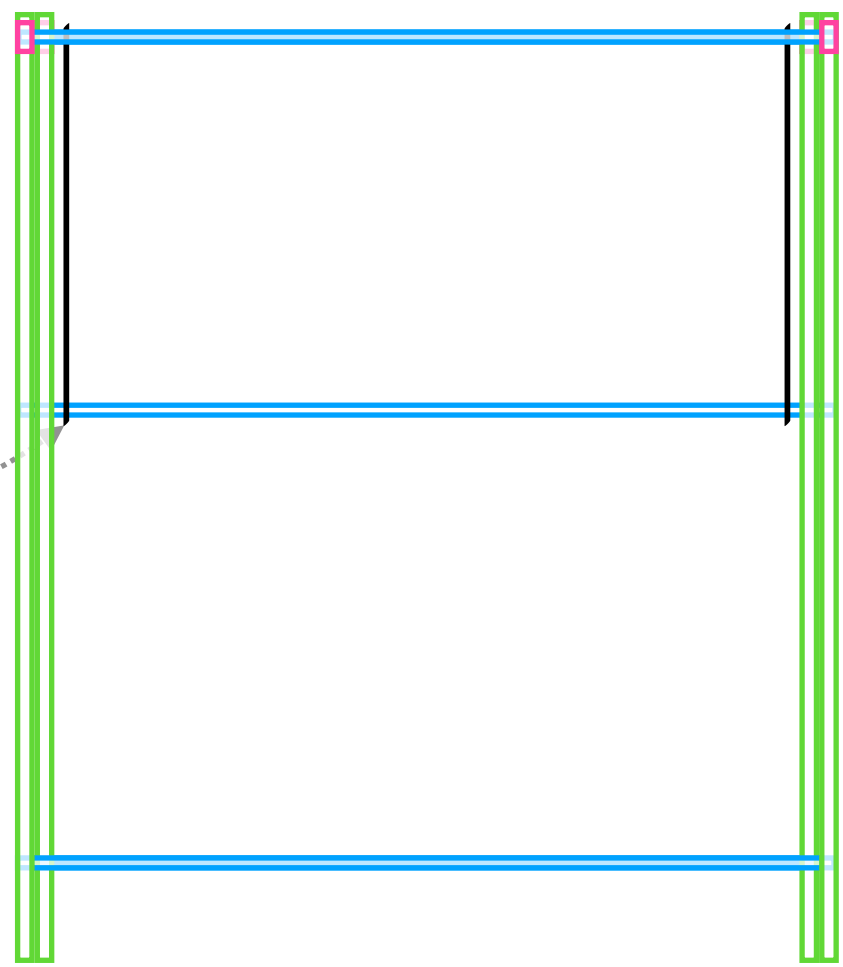


HOOK
